Buildings such as the Washington National Cathedral, Biltmore Estate (Asheville, North Carolina), Empire State Building, The Pentagon, Hotel Pennsylvania and the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum feature Indiana limestone from Bedford in their exteriors.

Lawrence County, Indiana is also the home of three United States astronauts. Virgil I. "Gus" Grissom, Kenneth D. Bowersox and Charles D. Walker. Located in Spring Mill State Park in Mitchell, Indiana (10 miles from Bedford) is the Grissom Space Museum which includes the "Molly Brown", which was "Gus" Grissom's Gemini mission capsule flight into space.
