- Malfunction drills during an ambush gunfight
- Officer Down ambush scenario
- Fighting your way out of your vehicle during an ambush and engaging multiple targets.
- Class is Missouri Post Certified/ \$200.00 per attendant/ Free entries given for hosting training

Required Gear and Ammunition: Eye and Ear Protection, Light Body Armor, Duty Belt used for work (Drop Downs are acceptable), Duty Handgun (250 rounds) and Patrol Rifle (100 rounds). *A long sleeve shirt is recommended.
