

DEFINITION OF APCA SANCTIONED EVENT

The following shall be defined as an official sanctioned APCA event.

1. The use of any material with the APCA name or logo to promote any training event, seminar or instructional meetings.
2. Advertising any event in which the APCA has a distinct connection to for the use of any party or third party trainings.
3. The use of any social media platforms in which the APCA is mentioned to enhance any meetings or training seminars by any person(s) or third party people or companies.
4. The requesting of any event to be posted on the official APCA website.
5. The use of any associated material, properties or any promotion of any educational seminar, meeting or training that relates to the APCA in any official capacity.

Any person(s) or companies who intend to use or host any APCA sanctioned event must receive prior authorization from the APCA President. All requests must be approved prior to hosting or promoting any event or instruction as it relates to K-9 and the APCA official organization.

The APCA President will further decide what, if any, compensation is required for the use of any APCA materials, logos, names etc.

Once the APCA has approved and sanctioned any event, all checks must be made out to the APCA. All checks and any cash that is collected for any event will be turned over to the APCA President. The President or their designee will disperse all funds accordingly, as per the APCA guidelines.

The hosting agency, company or individuals of any approved APCA sanctioned event must provide the APCA President a full financial accounting of the event. This financial report must be submitted within Thirty (30) days of the event completion.

Any APCA members or non members, individuals, companies or third parties, who violate this policy shall be subject to imposed sanctions to include suspension and monetarily fines. All sanctions will be at the discretion of the APCA President.
